

## SPORTS PREMIUM SAINT THOMAS' C OF E ACADEMY SPORTS PREMIUM 2019-20

Sports Premium Funding is money that is being provided by Central Government to improve the quality of Sport and PE in Primary Schools. Each year the school will receive a lump sum per eligible pupil which is £17,700 for Saint Thomas' C of E Academy for 2019–2020. The impact of the use of the Sport's premium is a key feature of the accountability of the school for the use of this funding.

At our school the money is being used in the following ways:-

- // To give staff an opportunity to work alongside PE specialists to improve quality of PE lessons raise fitness levels
- 2) To ensure that our pupils achieve a daily level of physical activity through the provision of lunchtime Sports clubs. These clubs are offered to pupils of all ages in school using specialist coaching provision. The range of activities is varied to ensure that children get the opportunity to foster an enjoyment in a wide-range of sporting activities including archery and tri-golf.
- 3) To increase participation across the school in physical learning opportunities in order to develop healthy lifestyles in our pupils by increasing the range of after-school clubs that we offer to pupils. Resources have been purchased for these clubs to run effectively. The cost will be as follows
