Year 4 times tables check

This year, the government have announced a new statutory assessment that will take place with our Year 4 children during the Summer term between the 6th and 24th June.

The times table check is an online check containing 25 multiplication questions. The children have 6 seconds to complete each question.

In preparation for this, children in Year 4 are busing practising the their times tables up to 12 x 12 and of course practising at home can really help too—Times Tables Rock Stars can be used for this.
